Overview

InfraWin 5 is the standard software from LumaSense for adjusting and controlling stationary, digital Impac® brand pyrometers.

This software allows the user to remotely adjust and control one or two pyrometers from a single computer. InfraWin makes it possible for the user to quickly and easily change pyrometer settings. The software also allows the user to simultaneously monitor and control temperatures.

After connecting the pyrometer to a PC, there are some parameters available in addition to the parameters directly adjustable. For example, the software allows

the user to set a sub range or allocate an address for bus control via RS485 interface.

A comprehensive online help function provides detailed information about all software functions available and guarantees an easy and convenient use.

Software GUI allows users to easily switch between six different languages: English, German, French, Spanish, Portuguese, and Chinese.

Software Features

Pyrometer Settings

An IMPAC digital pyrometer connected to a PC will be automatically detected by the software. All available parameters are adjustable, including emissivity, response time, maximum value storage, output signal and sub range.

Further special functions are adjustable for example controllers or TV parameters on instruments available with these

functions. Changes are transmitted directly to the pyrometer.

Measurement with Color Bar

In this window a temperature value for the upper or lower limit can be adjusted numerically or with the mouse.

The acquired minimum and maximum value is indicated as well as the inner temperature of the pyrometer. The emissivity is

changeable during the measurement at any time.

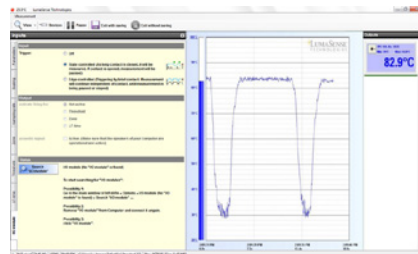
Infrared Calculator

After input of the aperture and the focused spot size per datasheet, the calculation of spot sizes at non-focused distances is possible.

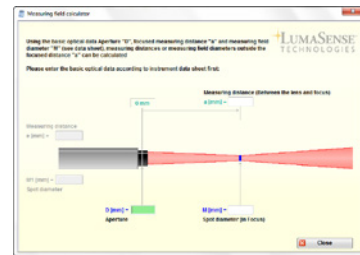
Examples



Measurement with Internal Temperature of radiation temperature and internal instrument temperature. Parameters can be changed during the measurement.



I/O Module allows users to trigger measurement externally and gives a potential free output contact.



Measuring Field Calculator allows the user to enter the aperture and the focused spot size and calculate spot sizes in non-focused measuring distances of the fixed optics.



Output Graphics allow users to review the temperature change over time within the specified temperature range. Displays the recorded time and temperature
